- ▶ 50 new Sworn Personnel, training, and equipment
- ▶ Enhance 5 Year vehicle replacement plan
- ▶ Increase funding for State Bureau of Investigation (SBI)
 - ▶ Human Trafficking
 - ▶ Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC)
 - ▶ Fusion Center
 - ▶ Missing alerts
 - ▶ School safety
- ▶ SBI Cost of Evidence Fund



FY2021 General Fund Request

▶ FY2020 General Fund Appropriation	\$ 59,809,245
▶ FY2021 Increase Requested	
▶ 50 new Sworn Personnel, training, and equipment	\$ 6,030,495
▶ Enhance 5 year vehicle replacement plan	\$ 3,500,000
▶ Merit Raises	\$ 2,990,918
▶ SBI Program Increases	\$ 2,000,000
▶ SBI Cost of Evidence Fund	\$ 81,875
▶ Central Alabama Crime Stoppers	\$ <u>(275,000)</u>
▶ Total Increase Requested	\$14,328,288



ALEA Sworn Personnel

- ▶ Sworn Personnel - 836
 - ▶ Public Safety
 - ▶ SBI
- ▶ 241 Projected Sworn Retirements in the next 5 years
 - ▶ 2020 - 80
 - ▶ 2021 - 30
 - ▶ 2022 - 72
 - ▶ 2023 - 27
 - ▶ 2024 - 32



New Sworn Personnel

- ▶ FY2020 appropriation enabled ALEA to hire and equip 50 new troopers
- ▶ In addition, ALEA is planning to backfill any sworn separations



Agency Issues

- ▶ Tier II State Police receiving FLC retirement benefits without Social Security option
- ▶ Over \$18 million of agency funding is not mandated
- ▶ Driver License modernization
- ▶ Automated Fingerprint Identification System modernization
- ▶ Information Technology security
